Launching the competitive entrance examination into **year one** of the first cycle for the University Technology Diploma of **Industrial Fishing** (Fishing-Navigation and Vessel equipments), **Marine Engineering** (Maintenance of Ships, Nautical and Industrial Equipments), **Aquaculture and Fisheries Technology** (Fisheries Industries and Quality Control) of the Limbe Nautical Arts and Fisheries Institute (LINAFI), for the 2022/2023 academic year.

DECIDE:

ARTICLE 1: A competitive entrance examination into **year one** of the first cycle for the University Technology Diploma of **Deep Sea Fisheries** (Fishing-Navigation and Vessel equipments), **Marine engineering** (Maintenance of Ships, Nautical and Industrial Equipments), **Aquaculture** and **Fisheries Technology** (Fisheries Industries and Quality Control) of the Limbe Nautical Arts and Fisheries Institute (LINAFI);

Fisheries Institute (LINAFI), for the 2022/2023 academic year is organized in the following centers: Douala, Limbe, Garoua, and Yaounde.

ARTICLE 2: GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR WRITING

The competitive entrance examination is opened to Cameroonians of both sexes who are holders of the following certificates: GCE Advanced Level in at least two (2) papers in sciences subjects. Baccalauréat C, D, E, F, Brevets de Techniciens Industriels except ITH or any other equivalent certificate recognized by the Ministry of Higher Education.

Those awaiting results are eligible to apply.

The age limit for candidates is between:

18 and 35 years for Industrial Fishing and Marine Engineering.

18 and 40 years for Aquaculture and Fisheries Technology.

ARTICLE 4: CONTENT OF CANDIDATE'S FILE

The application file shall comprise the following documents:

- A registration form to be collected from the Institute at the Service of Students Affairs of LINAFI, or at all the Regional Delegations of the Ministry of Livestock, Fisheries and Animal Industries, or can to be downloaded at the MINESUP websites <http://www.minesup.gov.cm> ; and MINEPIA <http://www.minepia.gov.cm>

- A photocopy on national identity card or receipt;
- A certified true copy of the Birth Certificates dated not more than three (03) months;
- A certified true copy of the corresponding certificates dated not more than three (03) months;
- A certified true copy of non-conviction dated not more than three (03) months;
- Two passports size photographs;
- An authorization to sit for examination issued by the user ministry (for civil servant);
- A medical certificate issued by a medical officer from the administration and testifying that the candidate is physically and mentally fit for sea profession;
- One self-addressed A4 envelope bearing stamped of 500 CFA;
- A receipt upon payment of **twenty thousand (20.000) CFA** as registration fees delivered by **BICEC BANK** to be deposited on account N° **10001068406351014000104**.

NB: Not other form of payment is accepted.

ARTICLE 7: The written part will take place on the **25 and 26 September 2022** in the following centres: Limbe, Garoua, Douala and Yaoundé

ARTICLE 8: Candidates are requested to come to the examination centres at least 30 minutes before the start of each examination paper. They must come along with their national identity card.

ARTICLE 09: Examination registration fees are non-refundable.

ARTICLE 10: Only candidates who have submitted a complete and regular file shall be authorised to sit for the examinations.

ARTICLE 11: The results of the examinations shall be published by a joint statement of the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education and the Minister of Livestock, Fisheries and Animals Industries.

ARTICLE 12: Candidates from foreign countries are recruited on the basis of a study of files containing the documents mentioned in article 4 and will only be definitively admitted after a medical test.

ARTICLE 13: The Director of The Director of Limbe Nautical Arts and Fisheries Institute "LINAFI", and the Director for University Accreditations and Quality are each in his capacity, responsible for the implementation of this decision, which shall be registered, published and broadcast wherever need be./-
