HEREBY ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1: A competitive examination for the recruitment of 15 (fifteen) student Court Registrars into the Magistracy and Court Registry Division of ENAM, is hereby announced for the 2023/2024 academic year.

The syllabus for this examination is appended to this order.

Article 2: The examination shall be open to persons who fulfil the following requirements:

(1) Fulfil the general requirements for employment into the public service;

(2) be a holder of either the Baccalaureate diploma or the GCE-A/L in at least two subjects passed in one sitting (excluding Religious Knowledge), the "Capacité en Droit"

or any other foreign equivalent certificate, recognized by the Minister of Higher Education;

- (3) be at least 17 (seventeen) years of age and 32 (thirty-two) years at most, as at 1st January 2023;
- (4) however, persons with disabilities who are holders of a National Disability Card issued by the competent authorities, may benefit from age exemption for a maximum of 5 (five) years above the age limit provided above, in accordance with Order No. 040/PM of 19 May 2022 mentioned above.

NB: Established civil servants are not authorised to compete.

<u>Article 3</u>: (1) Registration forms can be downloaded at ENAM website at the following address: www.enam.cm;


- (2) The registration fee for the competitive examination shall be twenty-five thousand (25,000) CFA francs.
- (3) Candidates must pay their registration fees in cash against a receipt at any BICEC branches.
- (4) Candidates can submit their application files against a receipt at ENAM in Yaoundé or at the Regional Delegations of the Ministry of the Public Service and Administrative Reform;
- (5) Application files shall be submitted at ENAM or at the Regional Delegations of the Ministry of the Public Service and Administrative Reform not later than Friday 04 August 2023;.
 - (6) The candidate's application files shall comprise the following documents:
 - an envelope bearing a one thousand (1000) CFA francs stamp;
 - a registration form bearing a 1,500 CFA franc stamp, previously downloaded on the ENAM website (<u>www.enam.cm</u>);

a certified true copy of the required certificate;

- an attestation of presentation of the original of the required certificate signed by the Governor, the Senior Divisional Officer or the Divisional Officer;
- a receipt showing proof of payment of registration fees for the competitive examination issued by BICEC;
- a certificate of non-conviction of not more than three (3) months as of the date of submission, signed by the competent judicial authorities;
- a medical certificate of not more than three (3) months old signed by a medical doctor of the public sector;
- a certified true copy of a birth certificate handwritten or typed signed by the competent administrative or council authorities.

N.B: All incomplete files or files containing forged or falsified documents shall be rejected.

- (7) The list of candidates authorized to sit the competitive examination shall be posted at ENAM on Wednesday 09 August 2023 latest.
- <u>N.B</u>: The publication of this list shall serve as individual notification to candidates.



<u>Article 4</u> (1) The written part of the examination which shall take place exclusively at the Yaounde Centre (ENAM) shall be conducted following this schedule:

a) General Knowledge

- a grand jury: coeff.1


